

Leverhulme Trail Walk

Distance: Approx 1.2 miles, starting and finishing at Powerleague, Leverhulme park.

The course:

Embark on a scenic walk starting and ending at Powerleague, exploring the picturesque landscape of Leverhulme Park. You'll mostly follow well-kept paths, with a bit of off-road adventure thrown in for good measure. After a rain shower, don't be surprised to find patches of mud, leaves, and puddles along the way. Make sure to wear comfy shoes!

Keep in mind that some parts of the route have narrow paths and a short off-road section, which might not be ideal for wheelchair users or pushchairs..
